Tailored guidance according to applicant's potential investments via telephone and/ or meeting. Written update of the agreed outcomes

CEA manages the application submission and liaises, if necessary, between the communal council representative & the energy professionals

Templates of the technical part of the Tender Documents for the approved investments to the communal councils

CEA oversight of the application procedure and submission of the application for funding
