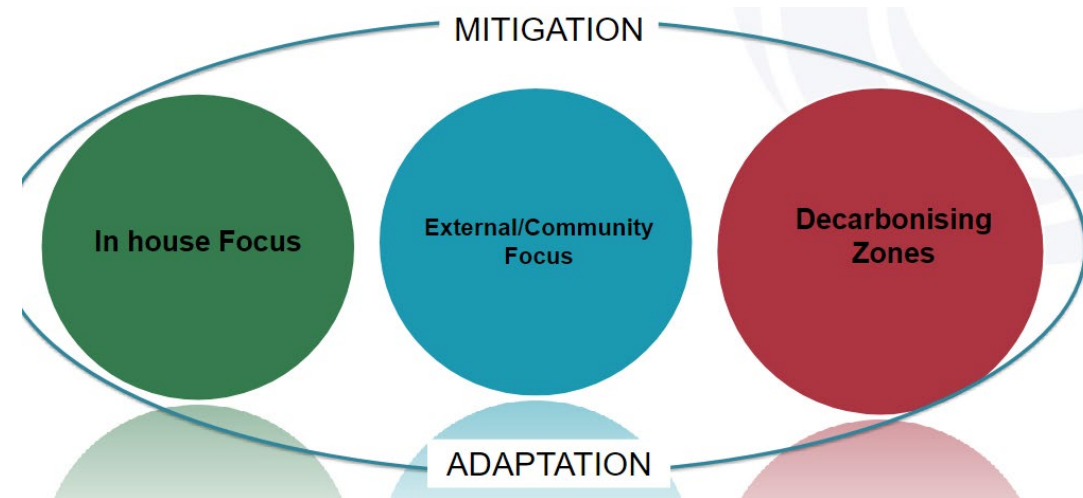
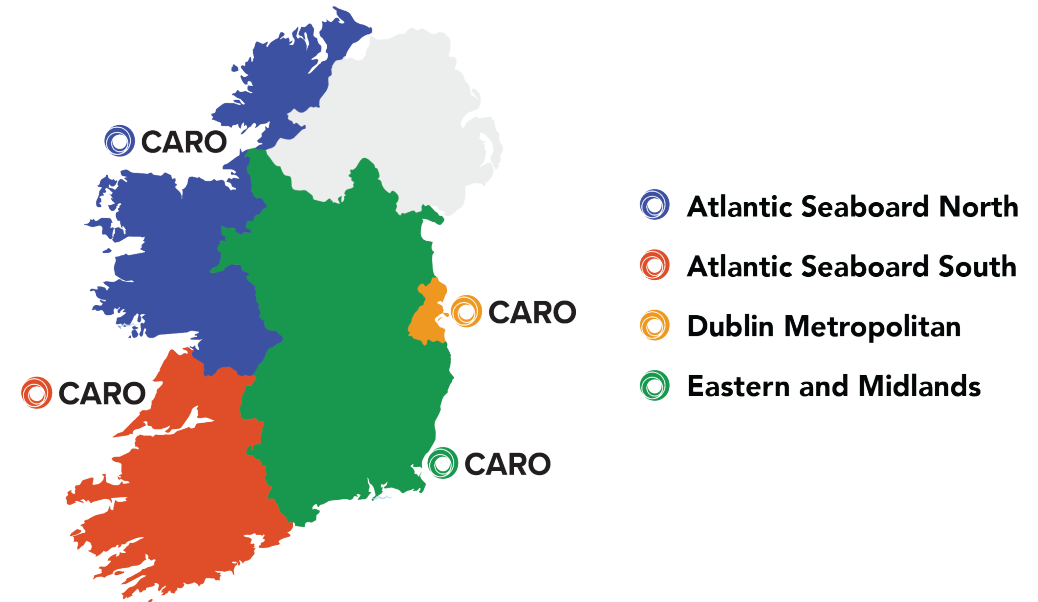

Tipperary County Council (TCC)

- Tipperary County Council (TCC) is one of 31 Local Authorities in Ireland (168,000 persons)
 - **Eastern & Midlands Climate Action Region.**
1. **51% reduction its own GHG emissions & 50% improvement in its energy efficiency by 2030**
 2. **Assist** in the delivery of the National Climate Objective at local, sectoral and community levels through **External/Community focused actions** across Council functions and services
 3. Identify a **Decarbonising Zone (DZ)** - a test bed for a range of climate mitigation, adaptation and biodiversity measures in a defined area

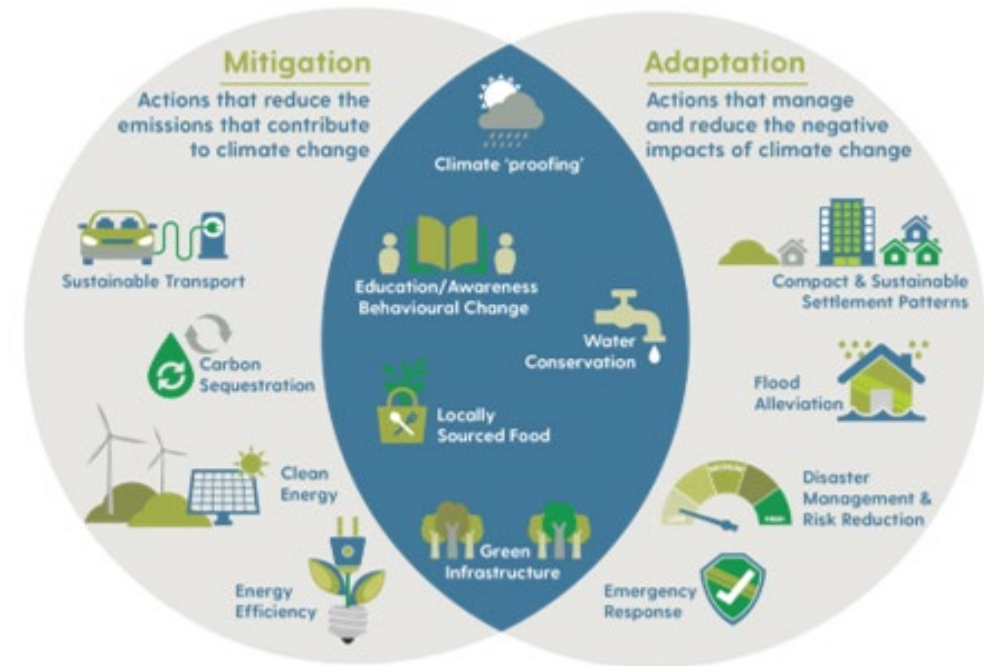


Local Authority Climate Action Plan (LACAP)

Climate Action and Low Carbon Development Amendment Act 2021:

14B (1) Each local authority shall prepare and make a plan relating to a period of five years (... referred to as a 'local authority climate action plan') which shall specify the **mitigation** and the **adaptation** measures to be adopted by the local authority'

- Direction to commence in **March 2023**
- **Adoption in February 2024**
